The 80-acre restored Amish farmstead, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is the focal point of Amish Acres. This heritage resort echoes the simple life of Amish society through historic interpretation, dining, lodging, theatre, countryside tours, baked goods and 8 quaint shops. A sixteen foot covered farm wagon with padded seats is pulled by an International Harvester H tractor and gives guests an overview of the historic farm as it travels down the gravel lanes, around the pond, past the historic buildings, and through the woods. Enjoy a light lunch in the restaurant barn. Enjoy the Quilt Garden at Amish Acres during your visit.
